

Lake La Thuile

Lake La Thuile is a geosite located at an altitude of 874 meters, in the heart of the Bauges Regional Natural Park. Of glacial origin, it covers approximately 5 hectares and reaches a depth of up to 12 meters. Fed by runoff and underground springs, it is surrounded by reed beds and wet meadows that provide habitat for fish, birds, and over 25 species of dragonflies.

The lake and its banks are private property, originally designated as a fish reserve registered with the Prefecture. This classified site is a natural heritage area to be preserved. It is designed to allow visitors to discover local wildlife and flora thank you for respecting this exceptional place.
